Due to safety concerns, we've established the following rules:

Non-alcoholic activities

We request that no alcoholic beverages be consumed before or during the activities. We've got a license to serve alcohol on our area, so bringing your own alcoholic beverages is not allowed, but there is a possibility to have alcoholic beverages served after the activities (must be agreed on beforehand, as we don't keep any stocked on site). It's important that the leader informs everyone of this, so that everyone will get the chance to participate in the activities.

"A little less drinking" at Base Camp

To ensure the safety of our guests, we wish to limit the consumption of alcohol. This is because we're out in the forest in terrain that is not too easily traversable and because there are campfires both inside and outside of Gamma. There are also quite a few torches spread around the area. Therefore, we hope that everyone understand that we do this to keep these events safe and free from injuries.

Everyone must walk back to the hotel together

We wish to conclude the evening at a pre-determined time, to ensure that any guests who wish to retire may do so. Alternatively, the guests can head over to the hotel if they want to continue to enjoy their evening. The guests will walk 900 meters in the dark back to the hotel, escorted by our instructors. We have some flashlights that the guests can borrow when we're walking back to the hotel, together in a group. This is important, to ensure that everyone gets back and nobody is lost, trips or receives any other kind of injuries. Along the way we will also pass by some private homes with bedroom windows facing towards the road. They appreciate that we respect their peace and privacy.
